Over the past three years, USANA has reduced its use of water, paper, packaging and electricity by implementing several environmental protection initiatives. A comprehensive recycling program was implemented that has now grown to include paper, cardboard, plastic, aluminum, manufacturing oils, fluorescent lamps, electronics waste, wood pallets and raw material drums. The company's xeriscape landscaping, where three acres of grass around USANA's property was replaced with rocks, mulch, trees, soil, low-water plants, walking trails and a sand volleyball court, has saved approximately 2.5 million gallons of water. USANA has also put solar panels on its warehouse, implemented a green vehicle program and installed high-efficiency windows in its recent office expansion.
